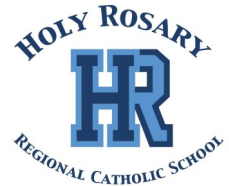

To the students of Holy Rosary School, their families, teachers, and school staff,

***Praise be Jesus Christ – now and forever!***

After the school's May Crowning service I had the opportunity to speak with one of the parents of one of our school children and "reminisce" about the tradition of May crownings. We, of course, complimented the fact that the practice of crowning an image of the Blessed Virgin Mary as our universal Queen during the month of May continues in our Catholic School. Depending upon your individual age, school, parish, and family the religious traditions practiced (I and this individual parent agreed) may have varied in some ways but generally had a "common thread" that joined them all together. We both agreed that May processions and May crownings could have occurred as many as "five times" during the month of May. There would be a "Parish" May Crowning, one for the school, one for "your" grade in school, one by the Parish Sodality Group, and one in your own home. I recalled that during the month of May our teachers in school would give us a "Miraculous Medal" with a "blue" ribbon tied in a bow for us to wear on our uniforms (ties for boys and dresses for girls). In the grade school that I attended, this particular tradition continued in the month of June by the students receiving "Sacred Heart of Jesus Medals" with a "red" ribbon tied to it.

It was nice to remember, and compare, and exchange the happy and spiritually uplifting feeling these traditions afforded us. Although certainly different in many "specifics" the "common focal point" of all these religious practices was the DAILY reminder of God's presence in our lives and the DAILY prayer and praise we gave to God as His children.

As we enter these summer months it is very important for us as a Catholic Christian community to continue our DAILY offerings of prayer and praise to God within our own homes and within our own respective Parish churches. What is taught and practiced in school can only be effectively sustained within our spiritual lives if and only if it is reinforced and actualized in our homes.

May we always pray for God's Spirit to guide us and for God's Grace to support us throughout our days to come. And may the blessing of Almighty God come upon all of you and remain with you forever.

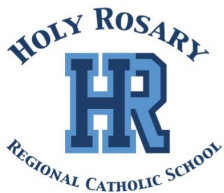
