



Hello Holy Rosary Families and Friends,

It is exciting to announce that Holy Rosary Regional Catholic School is participating in Giving Tuesday through the #GiveCatholic platform on December 1st.

Our goal is to raise \$75,000 so we may continue the cafeteria/gym renovation project that was started last year. During Phase 1, the space got a fresh coat of paint, 13 windows were replaced, 24 new LED lights were mounted, and new safety pads were installed. And now, for the first time, events can be held in true comfort with the installation of air conditioning. We were able to do all of that with a generous donation of \$100,000 from Mr. Thomas Cahill, a Board of Limited Jurisdiction member.

Phase 2 of the renovation project will include replacing the deteriorating lunch tables and renovating the floor.
